


## **RENAS**

- Established 1997 by two industry associations as a non-profit company

- RENAS will help build the principles of circular economy, which includes increase demand and use of recycled materials

# The EPR model





## **EPR**

- «Polluter pays» principal
- A tool for the authorities that works, and easily transferable to other product types
- Adapted in the EU, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and countries on every continent
- A system for handling environmental toxins and unwanted substances, and controlled recycling processes



# **«WORK IT»**

- Municipality (publicly) owned company
- Facilitate meaningful jobs for people with disabilities
- Funded by public money
- Operates only locally
- More than 300 similar companies in Norway





## RedolT

#### Why:

- Increase environmental benefits by catching «lost» recourses in everyday electronics containing sensitive data and valuable materials
- Focus on and target specific product type (phones, iPads, laptops, etc)
- Circular economy



#### Challenge:

- Getting consumers and small businesses to turn in old electronic devices with sensitive data
- Building a secure, <u>trustworthy</u> and certified supply and value chain
- · Handling (deleting / returning) sensitive data
