Professor Lutz Kilian is a leading scholar in time series econometrics, empirical macroeconomics and energy economics. This course investigates oil market models and the link between oil prices, the macroeconomy and monetary policy. To analyse these interrelationships, the students will be familiar with, among others, structural vector autoregression (VAR) models and Dynamic stochastic general equilibrium (DSGE) models

There will be no fee for attending the mini-course, but participants are expected to cover their travel and accommodation costs.
